Dear Parents and Carers

This week has seen students in Year 11 receive their mock results. It is important that they understand that the grades they have received represent their cumulative achievement to date and not just their outcomes from their exam papers. Some students will feel naturally slightly disappointed with these results, but should use this as an opportunity to engage with every bit of feedback, additional practice, content revision and intervention/after-school session that is available to them. We know that this is a capable cohort and the next few months will go extremely quickly, especially as they are punctuated with another round of mock exams and two more school holidays. Any support in the form of reinforcement, taking a specific interest and more direct/targeted input from parents and carers is much appreciated so that we are all giving your children the right amount of praise and encouragement together. Please also see the specific subject-based advice that has been produced by subject leaders after marking this round of mock papers in the Year 11 Newsletter sent yesterday.

I hope that Year 11 parents and carers have seen the letter this week from Mrs Cook and Mrs Abingdon - contrary to my communications with you all last week, our Prom venue has now reverted back to our original date of **Friday 27th June!** I am sorry for this confusion, but they have now cancelled the double-booking, reinstating our original booking date.

This week an exciting opportunity to enter the Art Bytes nationwide competition was opened up to all Year 9 students. Entrants are to create an original piece on either the theme of 'Flora and Fauna' or 'Humans', submitting their entries by Thursday 13th February 2025. The first stage of the competition requires the school to select 30 entries for submission to the nationwide competition, with these entries being placed on display in school. From these 30 pieces, three will be chosen by public vote to be put on virtual display, before being entered for regional and national judging. All entries must be 2D and can be painted, drawn or mixed media - no digital art or photography is permitted for this competition. The originals must be taken to Ms MItchell in Room 7 at Windmill Lane and a photograph uploaded and submitted to the 'Year 9 Art Bytes Competition' Google Classroom. We are extremely excited to see the no doubt excellent work that is submitted by students.

Parents and carers may be aware of our work in the Soft Federation with Sackville School, Oathall Community College and Downlands Community School. We continue to build this close relationship within the Soft Federation and are committed to our ongoing partnership with these schools. This year we have already seen some great success with further shared staff collaboration, training and development; the establishment of a number of cross-federation student events and activities (more information to follow in the future); a whole-federation day of INSET training; and a programme of highly constructive and supportive school-to-school improvement visits. We are extremely proud of the collaborative and developmental work of the Soft Federation and its impact. I look forward to sharing more information on this with you in the future, particularly with regard to the upcoming student events.
